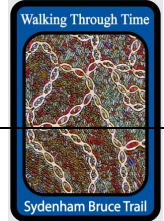


Walking Through Time in Sydenham Hike and Photo Requirements



	Name	Type	Length (Km)	Photo Location
1	Rocklyn Creek	Linear	7.4	Stop 10: Tributary of Rocklyn Creek that tumbles down a gentle waterfall on thin layers of Manitoulin Dolostone.
2	Silent Valley Loop	Loop	5.7	Stop 6: Any of the Fossil Hill Dolostone fossils you can find <u>and identify</u> in the barn foundation walls.
3	Silent Valley to Woodford	Linear	6.4	Stop 6: Rustic lime kiln, where blocks of dolostone rock were burned to produce lime.
4	Woodford Escarpment Loop	Loop	3.5	Past stop 3: Any example of a Syringopora coral (organ pipe coral).
5	Boyd Crevice	Loop	1.4	Stop 2: Close up of the walls of Lions Head Dolostone showing its brick-like structure.
6	Palisades and Inglis Falls	Linear	8.0	Between Stops 2 and 3: Wave cut notch carved in Amabel Dolostone during high water levels.
7	Memorial Forest & Jones Falls	Loop	3.0	Stop 1: Crinoid fossil in Amabel Dolostone walls of old dairy.
8	Indian Falls	Loop	1.6	Indian Falls.
9	Fossil Glen	Loop	2.3	Between Stops 1 and 3: Any example of a Favosites coral (honeycomb coral).
10	Savage Wells	Loop	5.6	Stop 4: Mysterious potholes/sinkholes in the Manitoulin Dolostone floor of The Glen.
11	Lindenwood	Loop	2.6	Stop 5: Large dolostone boulder that has been moved around by glacial meltwater.
12	Bass Lake	Loop	3.8	Stop 4: Spring that erupts between the Cabot Head shale and the overlying Dyer Bay Dolostone.
13	Kemble Wetland & Rock	Loop	6.0	Stop 4: Cabot Head Shale bedrock along the treadway.
14	Kemble Rock to Dodd's Hill	Linear	8.5	Stop 5: Fossil Hill Dolostone boulder that has been moved by glacial ice/meltwater to sit on top of Amabel Dolostone.
15	The Bluffs: Esther and Skinner	Loop	9.4	Stop 3: View of Slough of Despond from Esther Bluff.
16	Bruce's Caves	Loop	2.0	Stop 3: Flowstone in roof crack of Colpoy's Cavern.
